### I n t r o d u c t i o n

The Discipline of Political Science of Shanghai Jiao Tong University has a long history. In 1901, in order to reserve talents for domestic, foreign and financial affairs, Mr. Cai Yuanpei presided over the opening of the Special Class of Political Science at Nanyang College, which became the source of the Discipline of Political Science at Jiaotong University. At the beginning of the 21st century, the Discipline of Political Science began to rebuild. At present, the first-level discipline of Political Science at SJTU mainly includes political theory, Chinese politics, comparative politics, national security, international relations, international politics and international political economy, etc. The faculty of the discipline is strong, including Chang Jiang Scholars of the Ministry of Education, New Century Excellent Talents, Shuguang Scholars, as well as Distinguished Professors and Chair Professors of SJTU.

In recent years, relying on the platform of the university and responding to the needs of the country and society, the Discipline of Political Science at SJTU has shown strong development potential and ranked among the top in China in third-party rankings such as Thames and Soft Science. The discipline focuses on both basic theory and the practice of global, national and social governance. By strengthening the professional theoretical foundation, promoting exchanges with government departments and actively developing international cooperation, the discipline focuses on cultivating students' abilities in various aspects such as theoretical innovation, linking theory with practice, solving realistic problems and conducting international exchanges.

1. Qualification examination: In principle, the examination should be completed before the end of the first semester of the second academic year after admission. at least completed within the first semester of the third academic year.

2. Dissertation Proposal: Should be completed within one year after passing the Qualification examination. Students who have

suspend schooling for some reason may apply for postponing the Thesis proposal.

3. Annual Progress Review: Applicants who have passed the proposal for more than six months shall participate in the Annual Progress Review every natural year.

4. Pre-defense: Applicant can apply after passing processes review above and completing the dissertation writing. For the details, refers to “ The Implementation Rules for Pre-Defense of Doctoral Candidates of School of International and Public Affairs ”

5. Thesis review and defense: After passing the preliminary defense, submit the final paper for review and expert evaluation.

3. Publish two papers in CSSCI journals which are not in the list of key journals.

#### ☐ Identification Method for Academic Papers

1. The academic journals are included in the Social Science Citation Index (SSCI) under the classification of Political Science, International Relations and Area Studies, of which Q1 and Q2 journals (except for the top journals) are equivalent to the key journals, and Q3 and Q4 journals are equivalent to CSSCI journals. Papers reprinted by Xinhua Digest in paper form, China Social Science Excellence, and Chinese Social Science Digest are considered to be published in the key journals.

2. Papers published by doctoral students as the first authors are counted as one. Papers published by doctoral students as the second author (the first authors must be his or her supervisors or associate supervisors) are counted as 0.5. Papers published by doctoral students as the third authors or other lower orders are not counted.

3. The level of journals changes dynamically. If the level of the journal at the time of submission is different from that at the time of publication, the level at the time of submission shall prevail.

4. The academic paper should be published (including being accepted) during the doctoral study period, and the first signatory institution should be Shanghai Jiao Tong University.

5. Published papers should be professional academic papers in this discipline
